


Below is the piece of fabulous writing and a picture of Sophie G. from 6CD. Sophie's class has studied 'The Magician's Nephew' by C.S. Lewis this term and after completing the book they were asked to write a persuasive book review. Well done Sophie!



Narnia... where talking beasts roam... where a witch awaits... where a magical new world is born. What could be better ingredients for a fantasy book? The Magician's Nephew, by C.S. Lewis earns its status as a children's classic novel due to its brilliant flow, rich language and exhilarating storyline. This story could be enjoyed by people of all ages. Its backstory includes two friends who travel world to world via magic rings, seeking adventure and battling against evil forces in a new world created by an almighty Lion.

This book is full of innovation and vivid, wild descriptions which allow the reader to visualise a magical adventure. For example, who could imagine coming up with an original idea such as a powerful Lion creating the land of Narnia?! Comparable to J.K. Rowling's Harry Potter series, The Magician's Nephew certainly inspires the heart and mind with its fantastic plot.

The Magician's Nephew pulls on the heartstrings with its emotional storyline and 'coming of age' themes. One of the main characters, Digory, will do anything to find a solution to save his dear, dying mother. In this way, a reader can empathise with the character and applaud the admirable choices he makes, even when he finds himself facing many difficult situations and moral dilemmas.

The Chronicles of Narnia are certainly a popular and well-known series that continues to sell across bookshops throughout the world, despite having been written over 70 years ago. C.S. Lewis's descriptive writing and action packed chapters have rightfully been adapted into a successful series of blockbuster movies. Once you have read the first novel, it is nearly impossible to resist reading the others! All of these reasons justify why everyone should own a copy of The Magician's Nephew on their private bookshelves.

Therefore, because of the innovation, beautiful storytelling and heart-warming events, The Magician's Nephew is a book that everyone ought to read in their lifetime. It would be a shame to ignore or waste the talented work of C.S. Lewis. I highly recommend this magnificent story to all lovers of the fantasy genre.

### 2017 HSC Achievements

Girraween ranked 22nd in the state overall with 14 students achieving an ATAR of 99 and over. 12 students of the cohort achieved an ATAR score over 98. The highest ATAR was 99.70 (Maximum ATAR 99.95). There were 16 "all rounder" students who achieved 90% or better in 10 units of study. 100% students received university offers.
